


Couleurs Berbères / The Valleys by 4x4 / Essaouira / Marrakech

Day 1: Marrakech / Couleurs Berbères Estate

Arrival at Marrakech Menara Airport and welcome by your French-speaking guide. Transfer to Couleurs Berbères Estate. Explore the surroundings. Welcome drink at the Berber Sky Bar. Check-in in fully equipped luxury tents.



Dinner and overnight stay.

Day 2: Couleurs Berbères – Walking Tour / Optional Afternoon Activities

Breakfast, then walking tour to the small Berber village of Tifriouine, at the foot of the Atlas Mountains. Visit a traditional house with a mint tea ritual. Return to the estate for lunch.

- Free access: swimming pool, mini-golf, basketball, water polo, climbing wall initiation with supervision
- Paid options: Camel ride, Quad or Buggy ride, Paragliding initiation



Dinner and overnight stay.

Day 3: Couleurs Berbères – Fun Activities & Workshops

Activities & Games / Olympiads: Mobile Bridge, Caterpillar Challenge, Spice Scent Game, Maze Challenge

Workshops: Pottery, Arabic & Berber Calligraphy, Moroccan Cooking



Lunch at the estate.



Evening: Dinner accompanied by a local folkloric troupe, followed by a musical evening around the campfire. Overnight stay.



Day 4: Couleurs Berbères / Kik Plateau / Ouirgane / Marrakech

Breakfast. Departure by 4x4 through the Atlas Mountains. A winding road leads to the Kik Plateau with panoramic views of the Haouz plain. Cross small Berber villages to reach the holy village of Moulay Brahim. Walk through the village, then continue to Ouirgane through the mountains. This lush village is a refreshing and relaxing destination.

Visit the Ouirgane salt flats in an almost Alpine landscape at 1,000 m altitude. Continue through the High Atlas, enjoying spectacular scenery, reaching Lake Ouirgane with its turquoise waters.

Arrival in Tinmel. Visit its famous mosque built in 1153. Abandoned after the fall of the Almohads, it had fallen into ruin. Major restoration works between 2003 and 2006 restored its former grandeur.



Lunch in a local inn. Then drive to Marrakech. Check-in at hotel, dinner, and overnight stay.

Day 5: Marrakech

Breakfast. Full day guided tour of Marrakech: **Koutoubia Mosque** (12th century), **Bahia Palace**, a maze of corridors and staircases with beautiful gardens, **Menara Gardens** with its large irrigation basin

Lunch in a former palace in the Medina.

Afternoon: Visit the souks, each specializing in a craft: tajine dishes, glazed pottery, cobalt-blue ceramics, wickerwork, pottery, dried fruits & spices, textiles, apothecaries, glassware. Pass Rahba Kedima, the former grain market and slave market. Explore the lively squares and various specialized souks: wool, sheepskin, jewelry, leather, dyers, blacksmiths, copperware.



Dinner and overnight stay at hotel.

Day 6: Marrakech / Essaouira / Marrakech

Breakfast. Full-day excursion to Essaouira. Stop before the city to visit an Argan oil cooperative.

Essaouira, built on a rocky peninsula (formerly Mogador), is remarkable for its isolation and ancient port character. Designed by French engineer Cournut, its name means "well-drawn." Visit the fishing port, ramparts, and Medina.

Lunch at a restaurant. Free time to explore the city. Artisan specialties include thuya and olive wood work. Numerous art workshops of local painters offer surprising creations.

Return to Marrakech. Dinner and overnight stay.



Day 7: Marrakech

Breakfast. Free day on full board at the hotel.

Optional activities:

- Half-day carriage ride with a stop at Majorelle Garden
- Full-day excursion to Ouzoud Waterfalls (includes lunch)

Dinner and overnight stay.



Day 8: Marrakech – Departure

Breakfast. Depending on flight schedule, free time before transfer to the airport. Assistance with check-in formalities.

- Personal expenses
- Drinks (per person/per meal unless All-Inclusive in Marrakech)
 - ¼ bottle of wine (1 bottle for 4) = 4 €

 - ½ bottle mineral water = 1.6 €
 - Coffee or tea = 2.5 €

Optional Activities (min. 4 participants):

- 1-hour camel ride = 30 €/person

- Carriage ride with Majorelle Garden visit (2 hours) = 35 €/person
