## DAY 1: MARRAKECH / HIGH ATLAS / COULEURS BERBERES

Welcome and reception at Marrakech Menara Airport.

Departure by 4x4 vehicles through the High Atlas Mountains. Discovery of villages with traditional mud houses set against the red mountains.

Meeting with the Berber population, known for their hospitality and attachment to centuries-old traditions. Tea break with mint tea at a local home along the way.

Drive through the village of Asni towards Ouirgane, known for its salt mines.



Lunch.



In the afternoon, visit of the Tinmel Mosque near Lake Ouirgane, with its emerald-green waters.

Continuation across the Kik Plateau to reach the Couleurs Berbères estate. Installation in high-comfort, waterproof and air-conditioned tents (suite accommodation available upon request).

Aperitif at the Berber Sky Bar with musical atmosphere. Traditional dinner accompanied by the local Houmada folklore group. Evening around the campfire.

## DAY 2: COULEURS BERBÈRES / MARRAKECH

Breakfast.

### Morning activities:

- Fun games (Bubble soccer, giant slipper race, Berber tent setup, wheelbarrow water carrier challenge, mobile bridge, caterpillar game, mountain bike agility course)
- Workshops (Moroccan cooking, Arabic calligraphy, pottery)



Lunch. Relaxing afternoon to enjoy the swimming pool, mini-golf, etc.

### Optional activities:

- Quad bike ride
- Camel ride



Late afternoon transfer to Marrakech via the Takerkoust Lake dam.

Check-in at the hotel, dinner and overnight stay.

### DAY 3: MARRAKECH

Historical visit of the “Red City”, which gave its name to the country:

The Koutoubia Mosque (12th century), the Bahia Palace with its beautiful gardens, and the Menara Gardens with its large irrigation basin.

Lunch at the hotel.



In the afternoon, visit of the souks, displaying a wide variety of handicrafts. Each district corresponds to a specific trade. You will find tajine dishes, glazed pottery, and beautiful cobalt-blue ceramics. The basket-makers' souk leads to the potters' souk, followed by the dried fruit and spice market. The Smarine Souk is dedicated to fabrics. You will also see apothecary shops and glassware merchants. This alley leads to Rahba Kedima, the former grain and slave market. The lively square is surrounded by wool and sheepskin souks. You will pass the jewelers, leatherworkers, dyers, blacksmiths, and copper craftsmen.

End of the visit at the famous Jemaa El Fna Square.



Return to the hotel.

Dinner at leisure. Overnight stay

Breakfast.

Free time according to flight schedule.

Transfer to the airport and assistance with check-in procedures.
